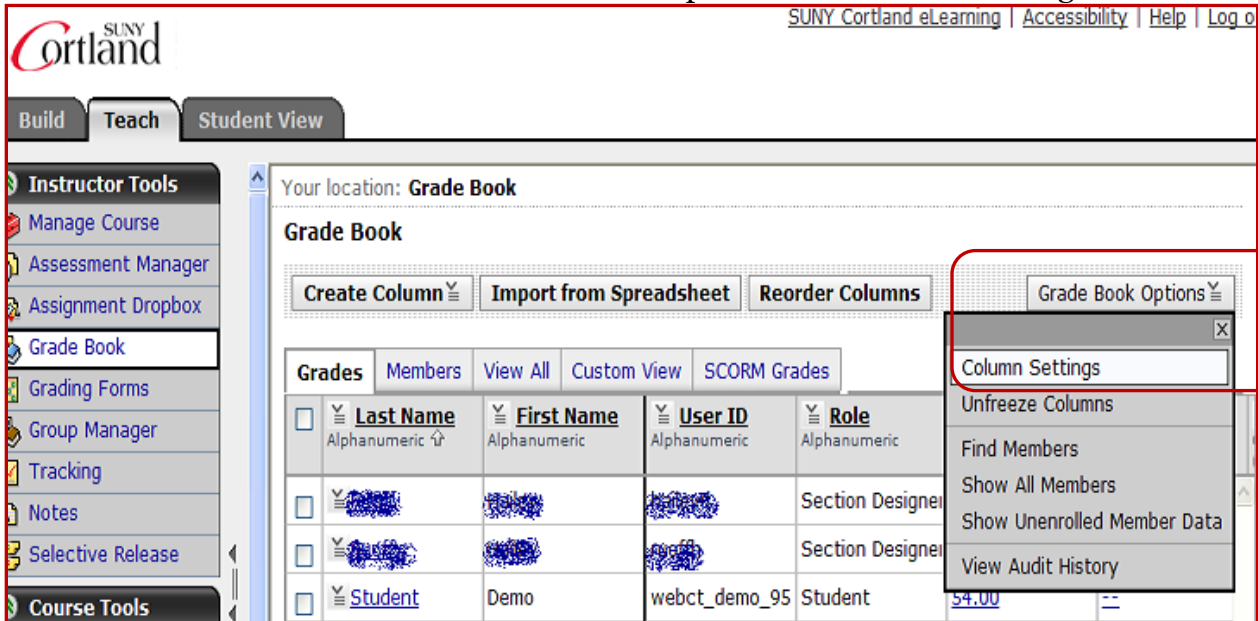


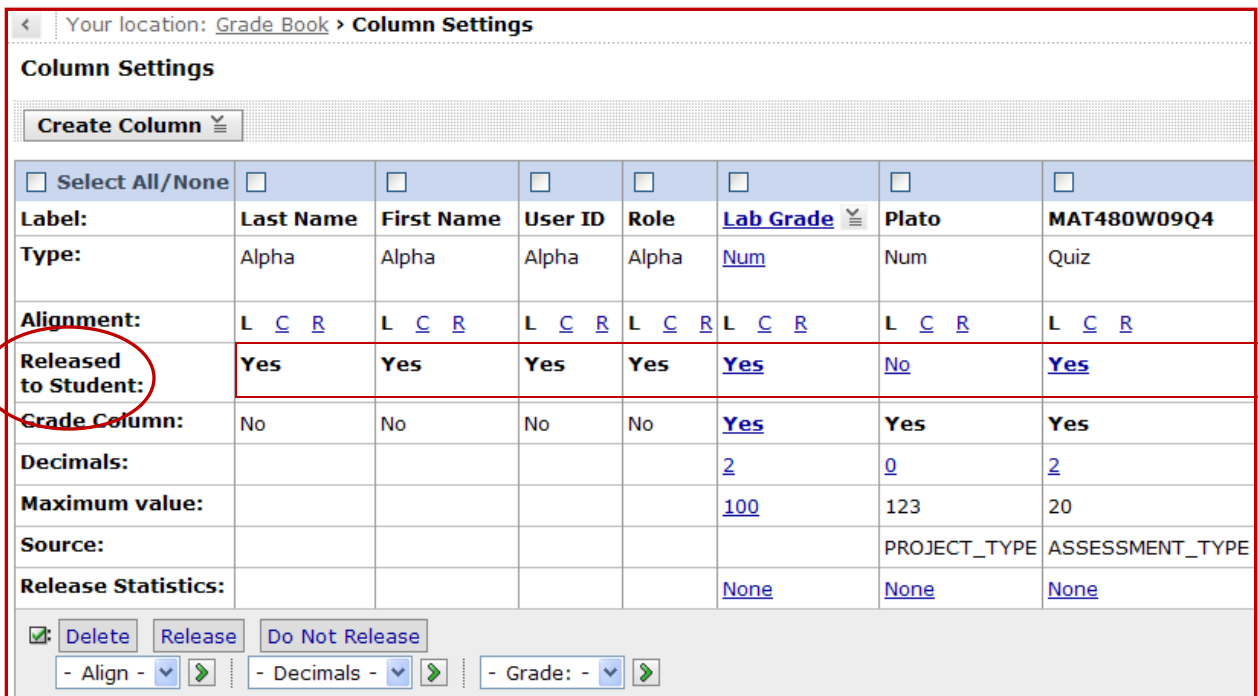
eLearning – Grade Book – Hiding Grades From Students

Inside of the eLearning Grade Book there is an option that allows you to let students see all of their grades, some of their grades, one of their grades or none. The choice is up to you.

Log into your eLearning classroom and make sure you are in Teach mode. Select Grade Book and then click on Grade Book Options then Column Settings.



You will then be able to choose which columns you want student to be able to see. In the first column find Released to Student then move to the right. This will show you what grades (or columns if the topic is not graded yet) that the student sees.
